It has been a fantastic week at Bygrove!

Donna & Charlotte had visitor in school yesterday who sent through this lovely feedback from her visit:

It was a delight to see your school in action, to work with you and Donna and hear about the amazing work you and your staff are undertaking .The primary observation I had as we walked around was the strength of relationships that were clearly evident between children, staff and children, and children and children. The way your school was zoned with interactive equipment enabled children to play and interact with each other with only occasional prompts from adults. Adults too, however, engaged with children with an enthusiasm and quiet authority that created a purposeful and calm learning environment - both inside and outside. I loved that there was a bubbling brook of conversation in every classroom! I was particularly impressed with your use of Zones of Regulation both the consistency in every classroom, established response and availability of adults as well as its adaptation for those who needed it to be more nuanced and individual. I so often see Z o R in schools that are visible but not the interactive responsiveness that your lovely school displayed.

We want to wish our brilliant Year 6 children the best of luck for their KS2 SATs next week. They have worked incredibly hard & we are very proud of them. You've got this Year 6!
