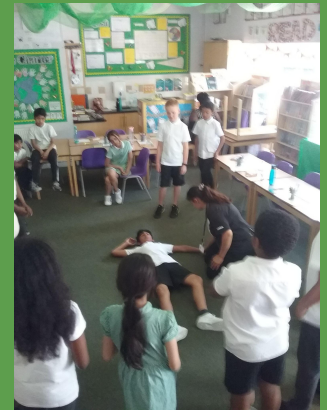
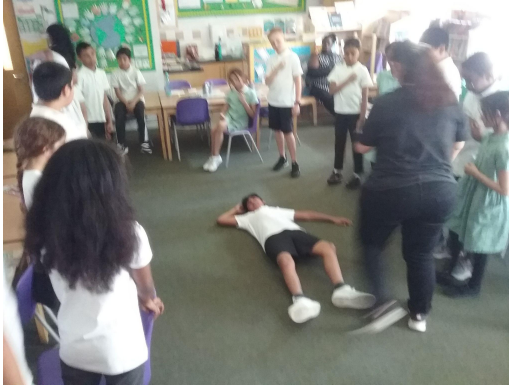
Fun Run

Inca Explorers

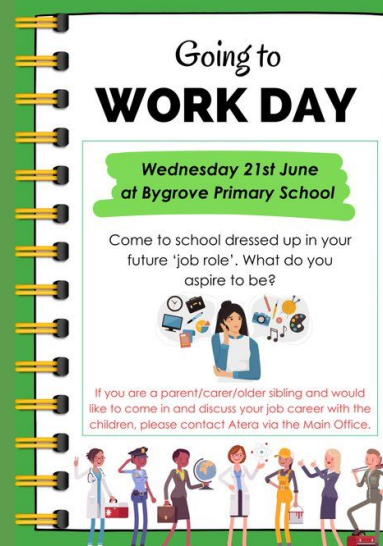
Inca Explorers showed incredible determination during last week's session on the high ropes. Well done! Thank you to the staff at Fairlop Waters for a brilliant afternoon.

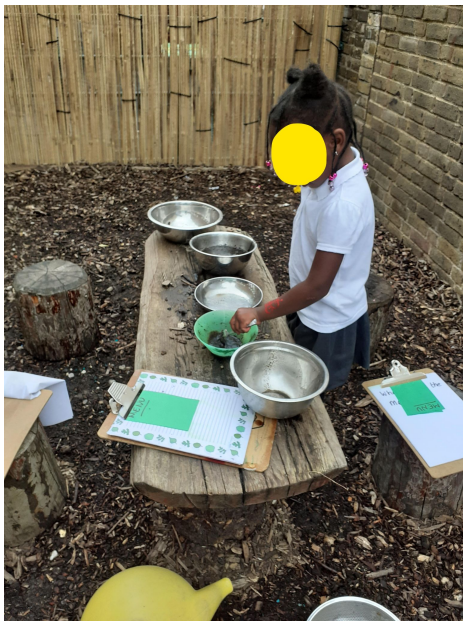


Going to Work Day

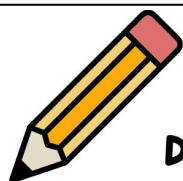
We are thrilled to invite you to our school's upcoming Music Showcase on June 26th. This event promises to be a celebration of our children's' musical talents and a memorable experience for all.
