## Nursery

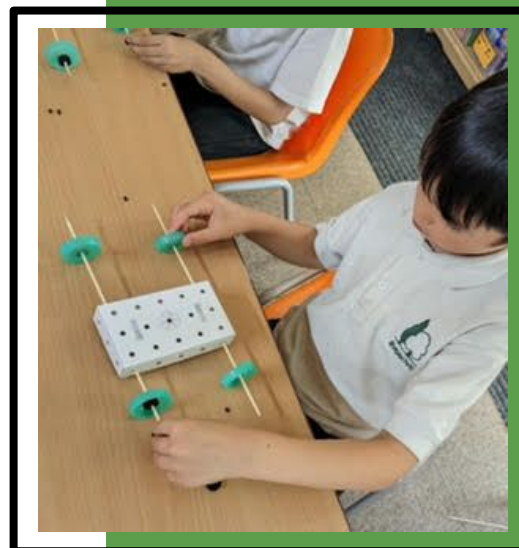
