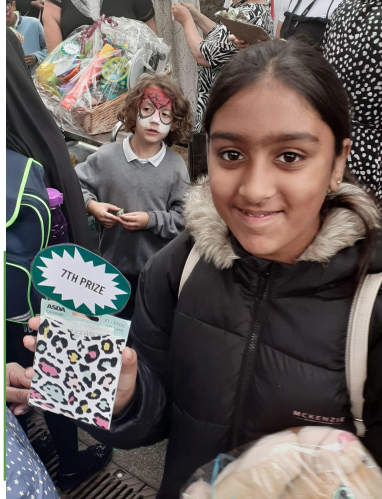
Reception - Year 6 children start the new academic year on Tuesday 5 September 2023 (includes our returning Nursery pupils).
