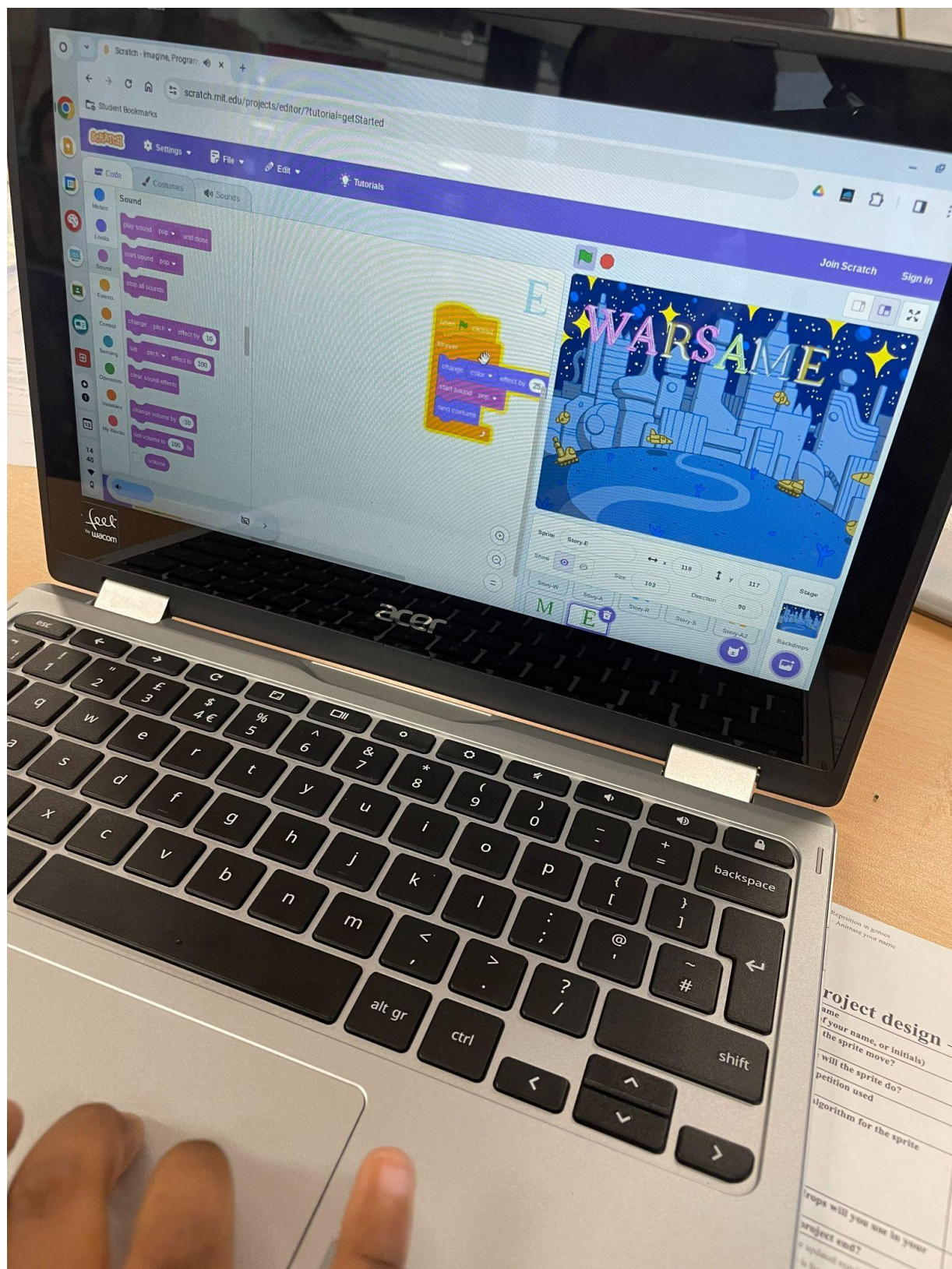
Year 2

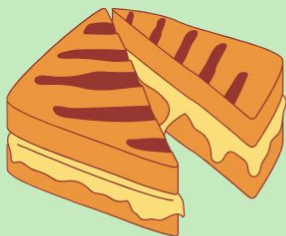
