In EYFS, you have learnt that emotions, movement and noises can be expressed through drawing & painting.

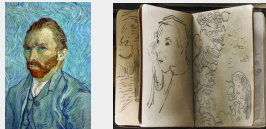
You have learnt about primary colours & colour mixing and used materials, tools & techniques to create sculptures.

**Key Vocabulary:**

primary colours	Red, yellow and blue are primary colours. They can't be mixed using any other colours.
secondary colours	Orange, green & purple are secondary colours. They are made by mixing primary colours together.
shape	a flat (2D) area surrounded by edges or an outline
pattern	an arrangement of lines, shapes & colours
texture	the way a surface feels, or looks like it would feel in a drawing or painting
tone	The lightness or darkness of something. The way light falls on a 3D object.
form	a 3D shape, such as a cube, sphere or cone
