Key Vocabulary:	
Observational drawing	Looking carefully & drawing what you can see
texture	The way a surface feels, or looks like it would feel in a drawing or painting
form	A three-dimensional shape
pattern	An arrangement of lines, shapes or colours
sculpture	Works of art in 3D
Secondary colours	Orange, green & purple are secondary colours. They are created by mixing primary colours together (red, yellow and blue)
