Key Learning

Every year is divided into 4 seasons. These seasons have different weather and different amounts of daylight.

Special things happen during different seasons. Leaves fall off some trees in Autumn, and flowers start to blossom again in Spring!

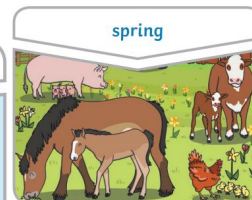
What have I learnt already?

The temperature is not the same outside for the whole year round in Britain.
Some trees lose their leaves in Autumn, which grow back in Spring.

Key Vocabulary:

word	definition
season	The year is split up into 4 seasons, each with different amounts of daylight
sunrise	When we first see the sun in the morning
sunset	When the sun disappears at the end of the day
daylight	When it is light outside
length of day	How many hours of light there is in a day
month	The year is split up into 12 months, these are about 4 weeks long each
