

Some of the children who attend Clubhouse took home some special boxes of seeds over the Easter holidays which were donated by a charity called 'The Pot Gang.'

In our story, Paddington had a tea party that also went wrong! The children have created some great actions to help remember the story. They even got to try Paddington's favourite food.







# Year 3


# Year 5

## Reception


The class is learning the model text for their new instruction texts. They are going to write an information text on an endangered species as part of their Eco Warriors termly topic.






