Reception have plastered the walls with their missing posters. Have you seen the missing Supertato?! Read the description to find out more about what he looks like so that you can keep an eye out.




Reception








This will help us write our very own warning stories next week!








Year 3




Ayat has been working extremely hard in maths and has become confident working with decimals. Well done, Ayat!
