English

1. Practise reading your high frequency words and see if you can spot them in your reading books.
2. Sing your favourite nursery rhymes to your family and teach them the words.
3. Describe the castle you have drawn for Science homework. What colour is it? Who lives there? How many windows does it have?

Science

What's your favourite fairytale? Draw a picture of a fairytale castle and label what materials you would use and why! Use as much colour as possible!

History

Look at a picture of your parents when they were children and a recent photo of you. Talk about what is the same and different about then and now.

Can your parents tell you a story about themselves when they were younger?

Talk

Play guess my character! Think of your favourite fairytale character and describe it to your family without saying its name. Can they guess who you are describing?

Art and Design

Google **Andy Goldsworthy images**. Go for a walk in the park. Collect interesting things like leaves, twigs, flowers, pebbles. Arrange them to make a pattern - think about colour and shape. Then take a photo!
