## Me and My Family

Have a bedtime story every night.

### Maths

1. Count how many steps it takes you to walk from one side of the room to another. Are there any rooms that you need to take more steps?
2. Go on a number hunt. Where can you find the number 5 within your house?
3. Arrange your toys in different patterns. Which do you like the best?

### English

1. Play eye spy using the first sound of the objects in your house.  
"I spy something beginning with..."
2. Pretend to be a robot. Use your robot voice to say objects in your home.  
"c-u-p" "b-o-x" "m-u-m"
3. Learn to write your own name and the names of the people in your family.

## Communication and Language

Learn to say please and thank you when you are asking for things and taking things at home.

## Physical Development

Take your family to your local park and bring a ball with you. Practise throwing and kicking the ball high, far or to each other.

## Wellbeing

Your family will often show you acts of kindness and love. What kind of things do they do to make you feel loved? What could you do to make them feel loved in return? Draw these things on a sheet of paper, and colour it in!
