Nursery

Nursery had a brilliant trip to the Thames Barrier Park. They enjoyed exploring the playground area & had a lovely picnic with their adults & friends. After lunch, the children had fun playing with bubbles & footballs. The children got to experience travelling on the DLR in preparation for trips in Reception. Thank you to all of the parents & carers who came along to support on the trip.





Forest School -Nursery

The children were learning to make little tents with natural materials. They collected some sticks and leaves to build shelters for their minibeasts.

In science this week, Year 1 have been continuing their learning about the human body. They were exploring their senses - see, taste, touch, smell, hear. For 'see', they used magnifying glasses to explore colour and optical illusions. For 'taste', Akosua blindfolded them and let them guess what they were tasting. For 'smell', children had to use their nose to figure out what scent it was whereas for 'touch' they had to use their skin to feel different objects and describe them. Finally, for hear, the Year 1's had to guess which sounds they could recognise. It was really fun and exciting!




