You chose from a range of materials, and used careful positioning and joining to design, make & evaluate an appealing product.

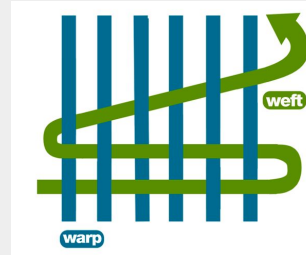


### Key knowledge that will be learnt:

### Key Vocabulary:

loom	A device used to weave cloth
warp	The warp threads are the strings on the loom
weft	The weft threads are woven under & over
yarn	a strand of twisted fibers made from silk, cotton, wool, or other materials and used for knitting, weaving or felting
textile	A fabric made by weaving, knitting or felting
