You will be able to say what legacy each significant person has had and how it impacted the life of those around them.

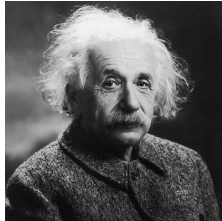
How will you be using your history skills?
