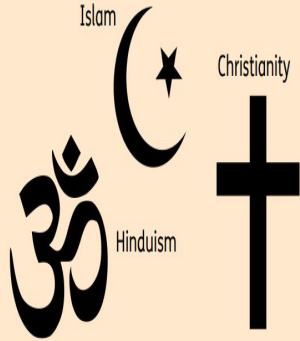

Key Vocabulary:

Pesach	Jewish term for passover
Palm Tuesday	Pancake Day, or Shrove Tuesday, is the traditional feast day before the start of Lent
Ash Wednesday	Ash Wednesday is a holy day of prayer and fasting for Christians
Sabbath	Sabbath is a day of rest, commanded by God to be kept as a holy day of rest
Good Friday	Commemorate the crucifixion of Christ
Easter Sunday	Commemorates Jesus Christ's resurrection from death
