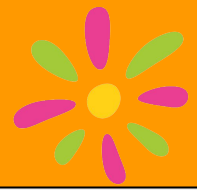

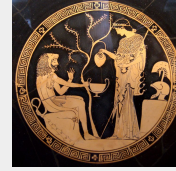
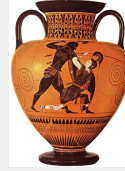
**What have I learnt already:**

In Year 1 (KS1) you learnt that artists think about the form (the 3D shape) of their sculptures and the ways in which they create texture on the surface of their work.

In Year 3 you used a range of clay techniques to create an eye-catching mask inspired by the work of the ancient Maya.

**Key knowledge that will be learnt:**

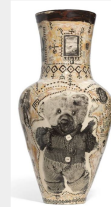
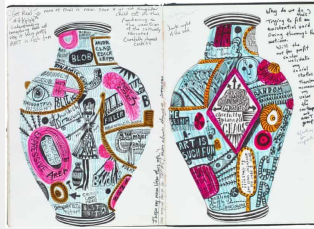
That the ancient Greeks used images on their pottery to tell the stories that were important to them - and what those images can tell us about ancient Greek life.



You will use coiling and score & slip techniques to build the form of your pot.



You will look at the work of Grayson Perry: a contemporary artist who makes pots.



Inspired by Grayson's approach, you will use your sketchbook to think about the composition of your design. You will then create 3D details for your pot that tell those stories that are important to you.

**Key Vocabulary:**

pottery	The art & craft of creating containers made from clay
coiling	A technique used to build the 3D shape of a pot
form	A three-dimensional shape. Sculpture & 3D design are about creating forms
score & slip	A technique used to join clay securely
composition	How elements of a design are positioned
space	The area between & around elements in an artwork
