

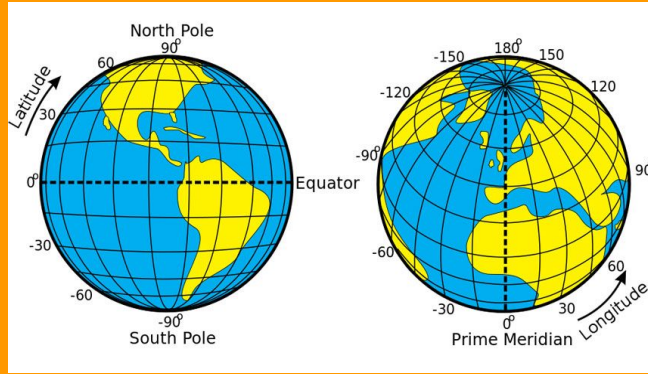

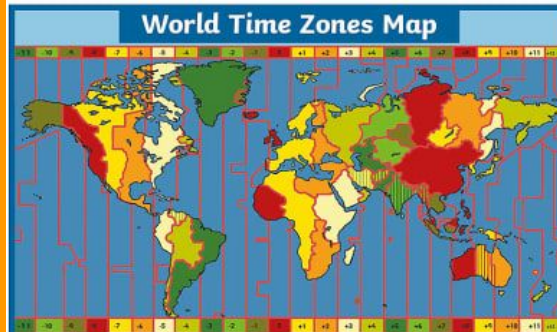


This term you will be learning to identify different time zones, you will learn to understand the significance of longitude and latitude and you will use digital maps.



We use latitude and longitude lines to **identify specific locations**. Latitude and longitude are also helpful in identifying landmarks.

Time zones are divided by imaginary lines called meridians and this is used to tell the time in different countries

Meridians	the starting point for the measuring system called longitude
Longitude and Latitude	Latitude and longitude are a system of lines used to describe the location of any place on Earth . Lines of latitude run in an east-west direction across Earth. Lines of longitude run in a north-south direction.
