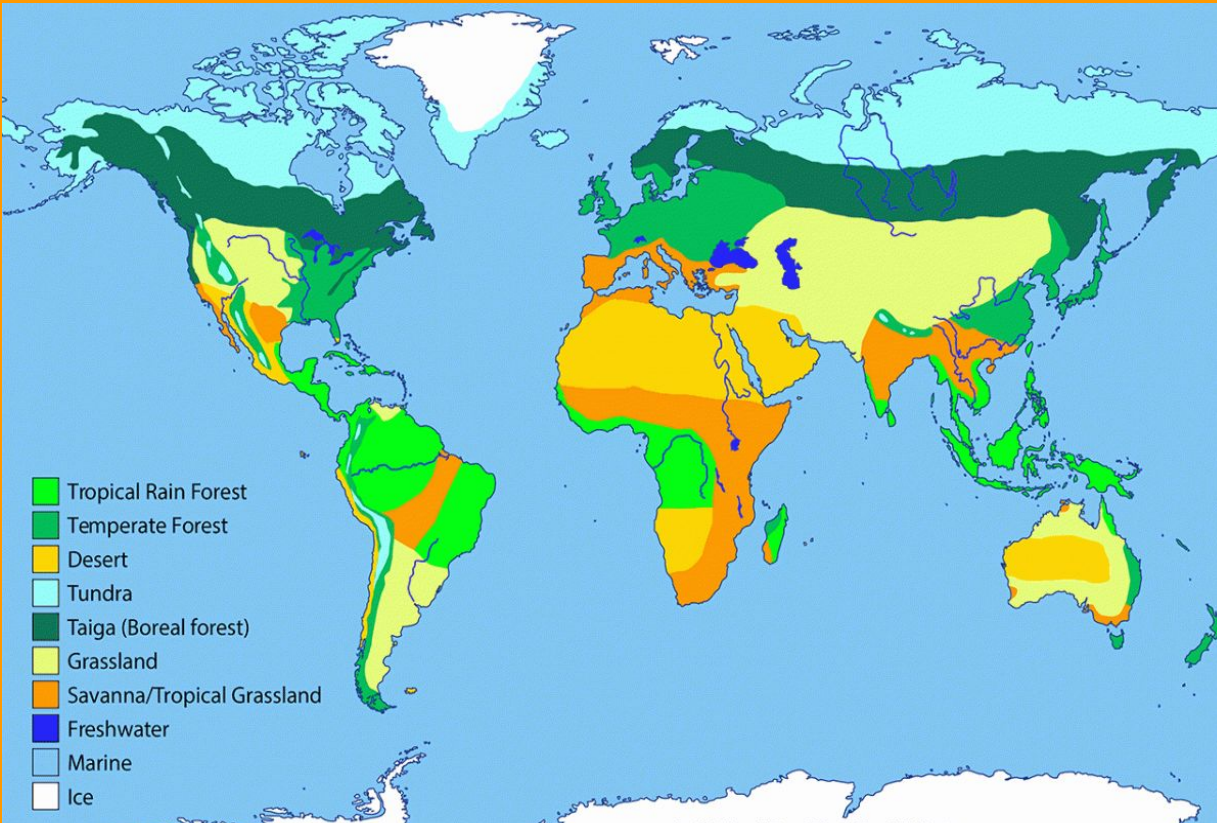

**Land use:** The changing and maintaining of land for human purpose

**Industrial:** Land used for manufacturing goods - factories, warehouses

**Agricultural:** Land used for growing crops and for rearing livestock (animals reared for humans to eat)



**Commercial:** Land used for shops, markets, shopping malls, high streets

**Residential:** Land used for homes, houses, flats and apartment buildings

**Natural land:** Land left instead of changed by humans - woods, forests, meadows, savannah, etc.
