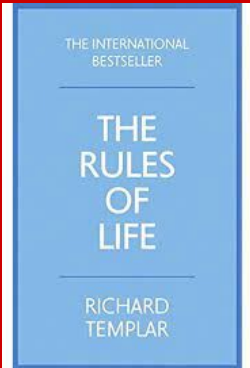

Key Vocabulary:

Community	a group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common
Humanist	an advocate or follower of the principles of humanism
Dilemma	a situation in which a difficult choice has to be made between two or more alternatives
Values	principles or standards of behaviour; one's judgement of what is important in life
