We Belong At Bygrove

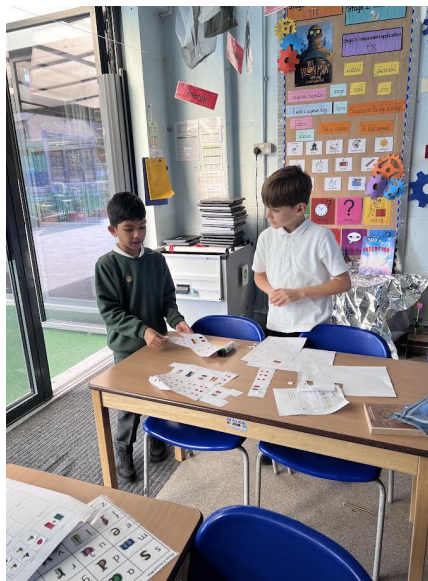

A big thank you to Raeesa's dad who supported us in cleaning up after the event. Your help did not go unnoticed and we really appreciated it!



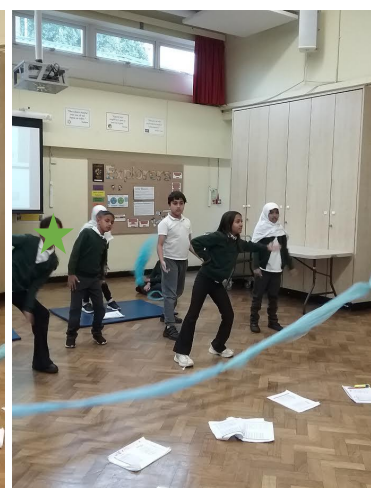
Year 4

This week, Year 5 have been working together to rehearse a scene from their show which they will perform on 22nd October.

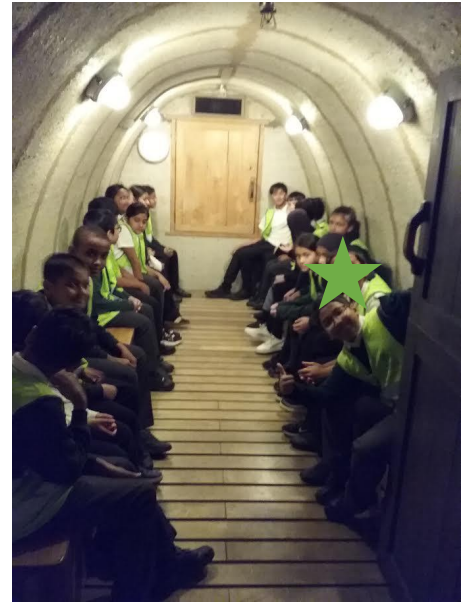
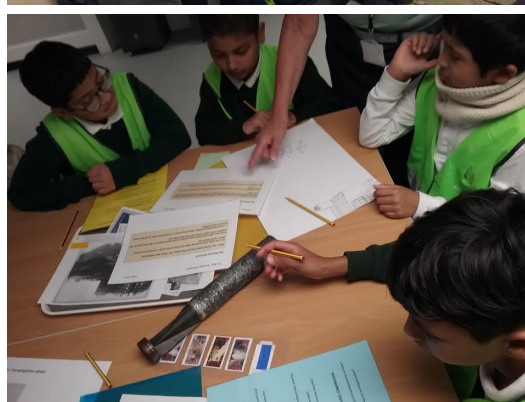




In maths this week the SLS children learned one to one matching through placing lolly sticks in ice cube trays. In science we learned how to separate items from sand using a sieve.
