On Monday, Akosua and I had the pleasure of carrying out a maths learning walk across the school from Nursery to Year 6. We were genuinely impressed with what we observed. The children are developing exceptional number fluency and demonstrating sophisticated reasoning skills. It's brilliant to see such confidence and enthusiasm in mathematics.

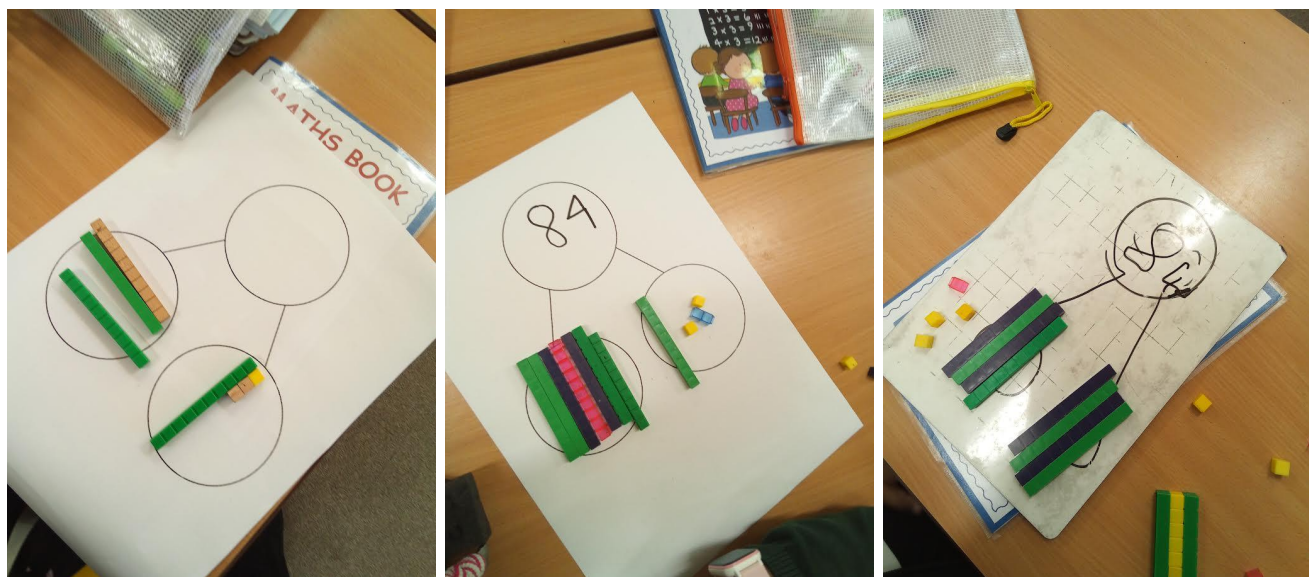
Nursery

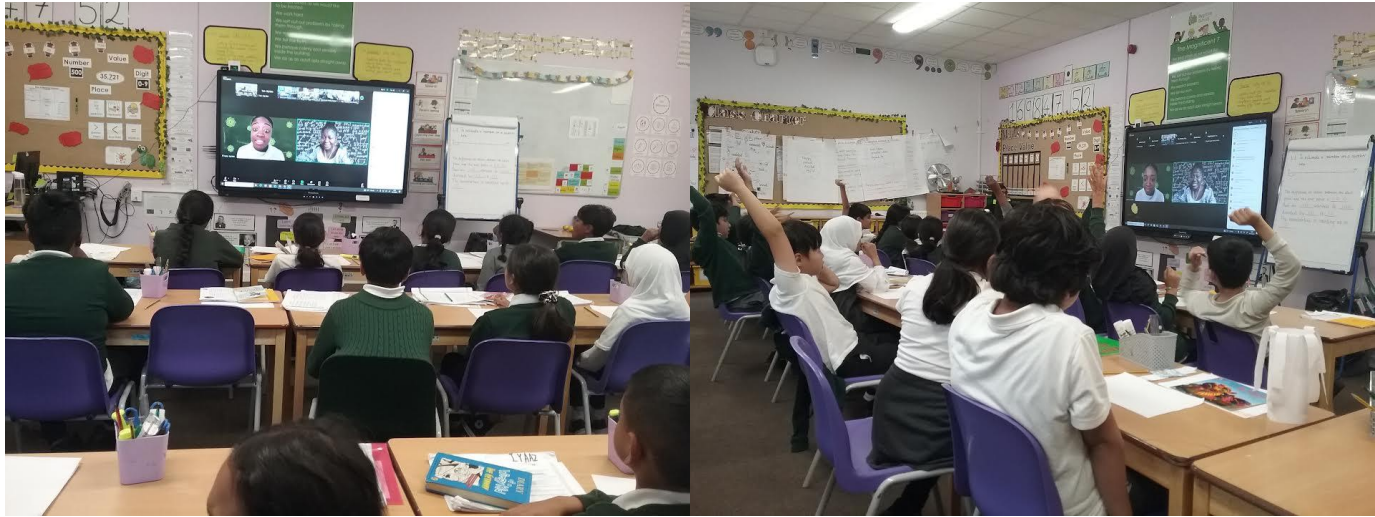
SLS
