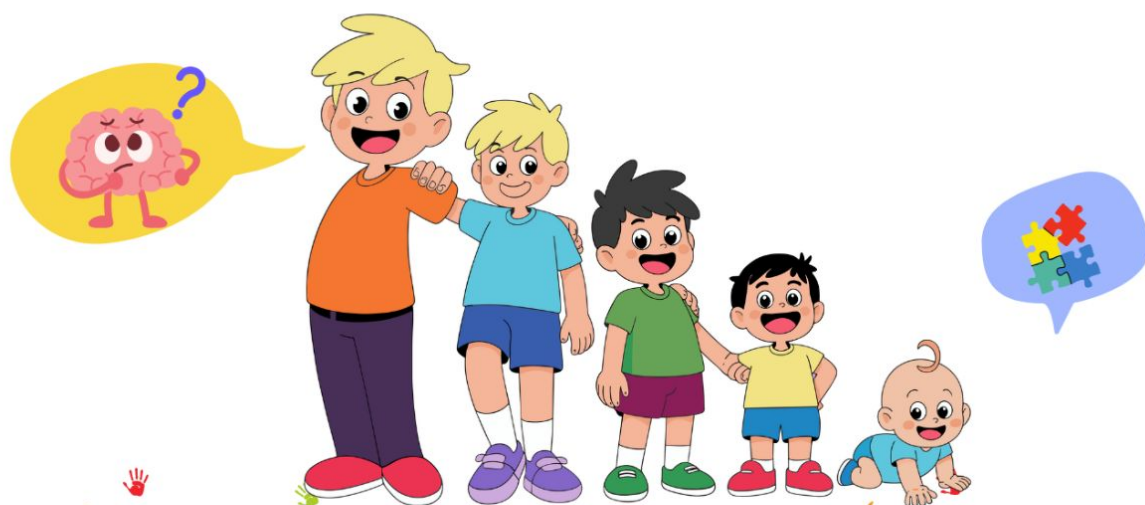

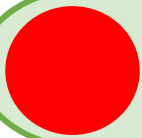

We had a very incredible visitor come in to see us this week.

On July 4th, 2018, Leah Chowdhry became the first, recorded, young British Asian woman to swim the English Channel at 26 years old.

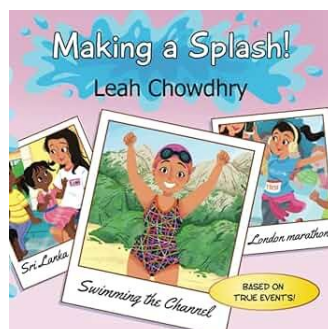
With help from family, friends and generous donations she raised over £175,000 for the British Asian Trust & many other charities. Leah completed the 30-mile swim in just 14 hours and 44 minutes despite obstacles like jellyfish, ship tankers and seasickness.

She has done many amazing things & even had a chance to meet the King.

Her key words of advice to our children were:
Understand your why & Believe in yourself

This fits in with our school value of ambition & we hope our children are inspired and DREAM BIG!

Leah also donated a book she has written about her expeditions to our school library!

Year 3

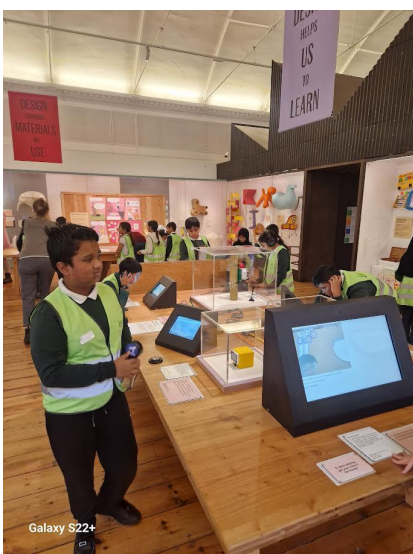
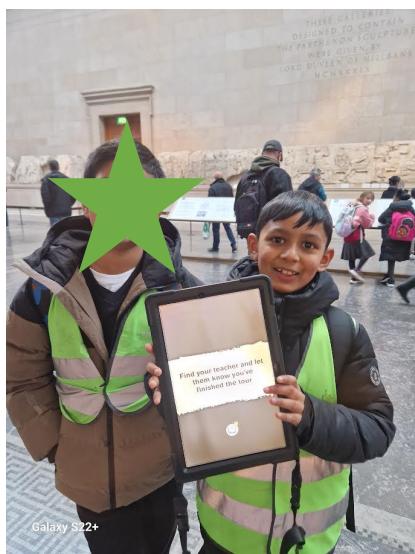
